

South Riding Baptist Church (SRBC) Covid-19 protocols for a return to physical gatherings

1. In an effort to reduce risk, we'll be gathering in the parking lot (weather permitting) and limiting the number of attendees to 35 for the first month and then increasing gradually to a maximum of 50 people.
2. If you would like to attend a service, please register via the link sent out to the Life Group Whatsapp groups, on the church's website (www.srbcc.co.za), or contact your Life Group leader who will register you.

(Please register by the Friday evening at 21h00)

Services will start at 09h00. Please arrive from 08h45 for screening. Services will be ONE HOUR in duration and will be streamed via Youtube/Facebook.

3. On arrival
 - Make sure you're wearing a face mask
 - Park your car or walk to the screening desk
 - If you feel safer to remain IN YOUR CAR for the duration of the service, you have the option to do so
4. Screening
 - You can queue on either side of the screening desks, making sure to maintain a physical distance of 1,5 meters
 - After sanitizing your hands, your temperature will be taken and recorded on the register
 - If your temperature is elevated, you will be isolated to give it an opportunity to "come down", after which appropriate steps will be taken
5. During the service
 - Chairs will be arranged 1,5 meters apart, please maintain this distance at all times
 - Anyone using the mic must ensure that it is sanitized before and after using it
 - The ONE HOUR service will include a time of worship, a short message, testimonies and prayer
 - In the event of unfavourable weather, the service will be held inside

6. Limited use of the building
 - As far as possible, try to limit toilet usage; but if you do need to go, sanitize your hands and the toilet facilities before *and* after use
 - The cry room will be available for moms who need to feed or change their babies; Limited to a maximum of TWO moms and face masks are compulsory
 - We're encouraging you to continue paying tithes and offerings electronically, but for those who do bring physical cash, you can walk through the church building after the service and place your offerings in the bags

7. For now there will be:
 - No Sunday School or Toddler's classes
 - No refreshments
 - No hugging or shaking of hands

8. We will make every effort to ensure a safe environment, but it is your responsibility to WEAR YOUR MASK, SANITIZE YOUR HANDS, KEEP YOUR DISTANCE and ADHERE TO ALL THE HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS.
